RIDE RATING: Moderate
RIDE SPEED: The trails are for the most part single file travel and self-regulating for speed.
TERRAIN: Similar to Porcupine Hills but with some higher elevations in places. Some rocky areas. Some gravel. If your horse has sensitive feet you may want shoes or boots.

RIDE DETAILS: Note the following:

- The Hosts will be onsite by Friday morning
- Check SATRA site often for weather and road updates
- Expect minor delays related to trail clearing
- Bring a long sleeved shirt as there may be some close contact to branches
- Some dismounting of your horse may be required
- Saturday/Sunday rides will/could last till late afternoon
- Potluck supper after Saturday's ride with fun and games to follow



RIDERS CAMP: All non-living quarters trailers must be parked outside the main camping area. There is an onsite outhouse, potable water tap, free firewood, individual fireboxes and a centralized communal fire ring.

FEES: SATRA will pay camping fees for all participating members in good standing. Cost is expected to be \$18 - \$20 per night.

HORSE CAMP: ONLY PROCESSED FEED IS ALLOWED ONSITE. The Ranger station keeps a supply of cubes on hand if you run short. There are pole tie stalls, a few panel box stalls and a large field. Electric fencing is allowed ONLY inside the turnout field. Horses may come into the camping area for saddling or while enroute to water or a trail however **no grazing**. All manure must be cleaned out of pens and stalls and carried to the compost pile. To keep the flies down, It is also your responsibility to pick up anything the horse leaves behind while travelling through the camping area.
