Take secondary highway #23 (Vulcan) to Champion.

Just past Champion turn right on the 529 toward Little Bow Provincial Park (road is paved). Travel approximately 14 kilometres.

At the top of the big hill you will see the overhead "Fleetwood" sign on the right. Turn in, when you arrive at the yard, park on the left.
