## Map and diagrams:

- 1. From Hwy 3 travel to Hwy 22
- 2. Travel north on Hwy 22 for 24 km
- 3. Turn off the highway at Maycroft campground just north of the Oldman river
- 3. Take the right turn onto Bob Creek road rather than driving down into the campground
- 4. Follow the Bob Creek road for 13 km (there is a bed and breakfast sign)
- 5. Turn right on the road toward the building at the B&B sign in 13 km
- 6. Turn sharp left before the gate to the yard (if your rig is too large you can turn around in the yard and return through the gate). Pick a spot, unload your horse and enjoy your weekend.

Note that there are no bathroom facilities available, and each camping unit must accommodate it's own needs.
