Draw a detailed **Map** below of how to get to the ride site and ride site details, giving approximate mileage. Please include RR or Township numbers and GPS coordinates if available. Use reverse or another sheet if more room is needed.

Map and diagrams:

1. From Hwy 3 - travel to Hwy 22
2. Travel north on Hwy 22 for 24 km
3. Turn off the highway at Maycroft campground just north of the Oldman river
3. Take the right turn onto Bob Creek road rather than driving down into the campground
4. Follow the Bob Creek road for 13 km (there is a bed and breakfast sign)
5. Turn right on the road toward the building at the B&B sign in 13 km
6. Turn sharp left before the gate to the yard (if your rig is too large you can turn around in the yard and return through the gate). Pick a spot, unload your horse and enjoy your weekend.

Note that there are no bathroom facilities available, and each camping unit must accommodate it's own needs.
