East on #1 Hwy to Maple Creek turn off. South on Hwy #21, first right after crossing tracks. Continue parallel track to tee intersection west side of town. Turn left to continue travel south on Hwy #21. Follow signs to Fort Walsh and Cypress Hills by turning right onto Hwy #724 near the south outskirts of town. Travel west and just before the gravel turn left/south onto Hwy #271. Travel approx. 48 km to the base of Cypress Hills. Right turn following signs to Westblock Ranger Station. Once on top of “the bench” do NOT turn left at Fort Walsh sign. Suggestion of dropping a gear before proceeding down the final grades past the Ranger Station with an immediate left after that (marked) into the Equestrian Campground. If you cross the bridge? You’ve missed the turn.
