Details of Ride

Bob Creek branding corrals and staging area available after 3:00 pm Sept 4, 2020.

- Water and pens available for horses. You may want to bring a wagon for transporting supplies. Pens are to be cleaned as required and completely cleaned before leaving at the end of the ride. Please bring your own drinking water as well.
- Camping area is at the branding staging area at Bob's Creek Ranch. Pens available. No electric fence or hi lining permitted. **Do Not Drive into the Bob's Creek Ranch House area.**
- There are no washroom facilities or garbage disposal. Please take home what you brought .
- Cost to camp is **\$ 20.00 night per rig and \$ 5.00** for each horse. **Tents are considered a unit.** There are no bathrooms or garbage facilities. Plan to bring your own facilities, and remember to take garbage home.
- Potluck supper on Saturday night. With Covid – some people may be more comfortable to bring their own meals. Please advise of your preference.
- **NOTE:** If we do not have **6 or more units confirmed by August 25, 2020** this ride will either be cancelled or no longer be considered a SATRA Ride.
- **Saturday** a 5-6 hour ride is planned, Sunday a 4 hour ride is planned and Monday a 2 hour ride will be planned. Saturday ride to start at 9:30, Sunday and Monday ride to start at 10:00 am – or as decided the night before the ride. We will stop for lunch breaks.
- Riders are to phone Alice Todd by **August 25, 2020** if they are planning to attend this ride. **ONLY CONFIRMED** riders will be advised of cancelled rides.

Directions From Hwy 3 and Hwy 22. For participants traveling from the south.

- 1. Turn north off hwy 3 onto hwy 22. Travel north on Hwy 22 for 24 km.**
- 2. Turn left (west) at first turn off Hwy 22, after crossing the Maycroft Bridge. Turn north at the Bob Creek sign. Do not go to the campground at the river.**
- 3. Travel north 11 kms on the Bob Creek Road. You will see the corrals to the left (west). Come in to corrals pick a spot for your unit, pick a pen, unload your horse and sit back and enjoy the scenery.**
